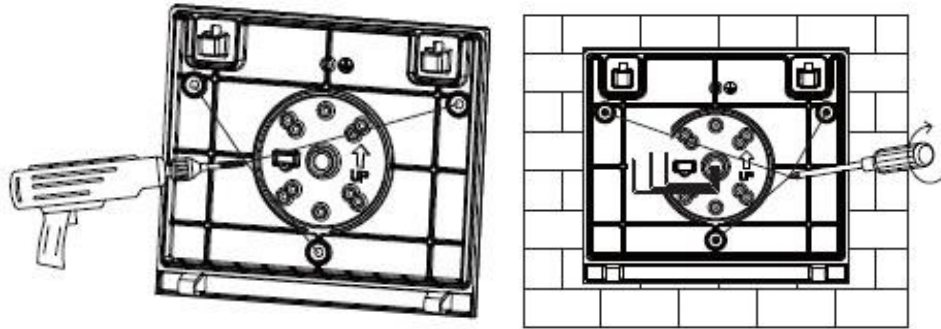
Installation Instructions

<p>1. Turn off the main power from the breaker panel.</p>	
<p>2. Loosen and remove the four screws from the top and sides of the fixture, holding the front cover to prevent it from falling.</p>	
<p>3. Open the light and remove the cover.</p> <p>If you do not need the photocell function, disconnect the male and female connector (see Photocell section for more information).</p>	
<p>4. Unscrew the 1/2" plug and attach an EVA foam pad (included).</p>	



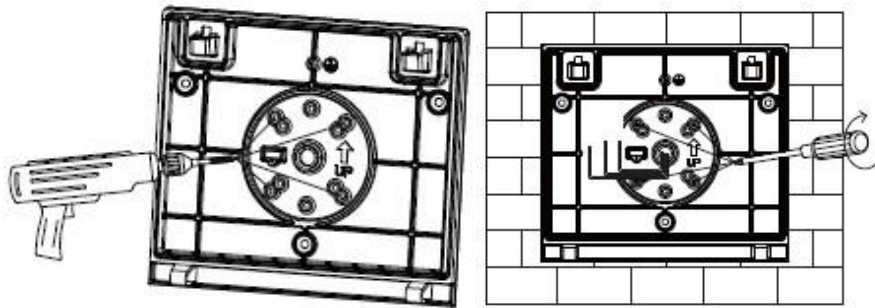
5. Wall Mount Installation

- a. Drill through three mounting holes using an electric drill.
- b. Attach the EVA foam pad (included) to the base of the fixture. Attach the base of the fixture to the wall with screws (not provided).

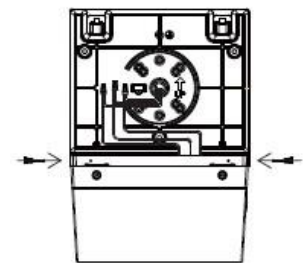


J-Box Installation

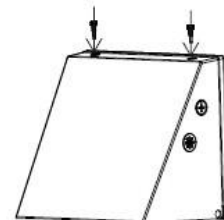
- a. Drill through the mounting holes using an electric drill.
- b. Attach the EVA foam pad (included) to the base of the fixture. Attach the fixture base to the J-box with screws (not provided).



6. Fasten the screws and connect the L, N, and G wires to the power supply. Refer to the Wiring Diagram section.



7. Mount the cover back onto the base of the fixture with the screws and seal the mounting surface with waterproof sealant (not provided).



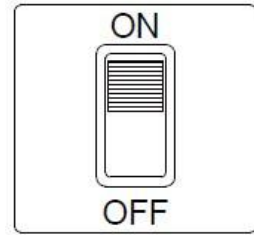


COLOR/WATTAGE SELECTABLE LED WALL PACK W/ PHOTOCELL

8. Select the desired wattage and color temperature using the DIP switches (see Adjustable Wattage & Color Temperature section for more information). Make sure the installation is complete before turning the power back on.

NOTE: The fixture must be turned OFF when selecting the CCT and wattage.

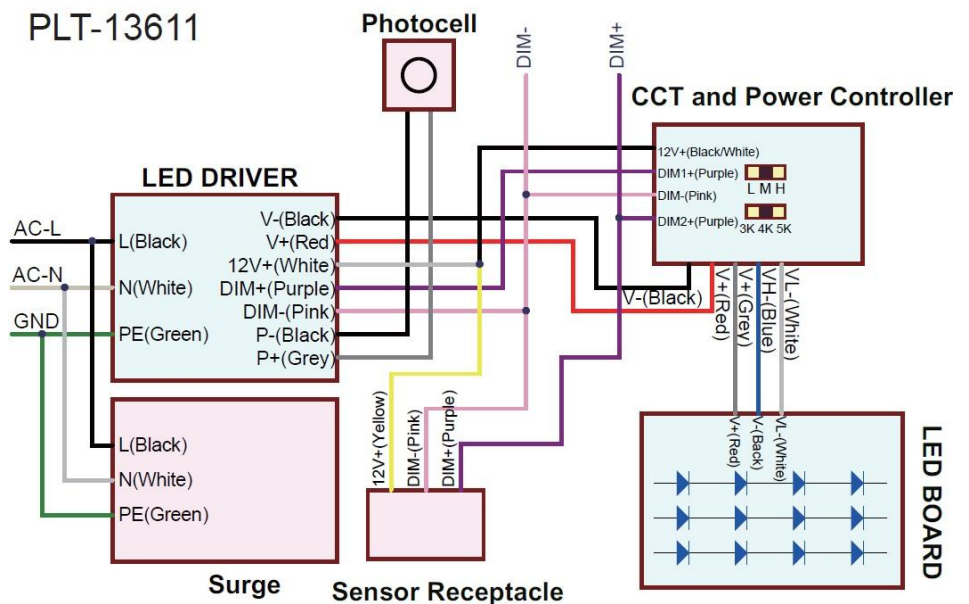
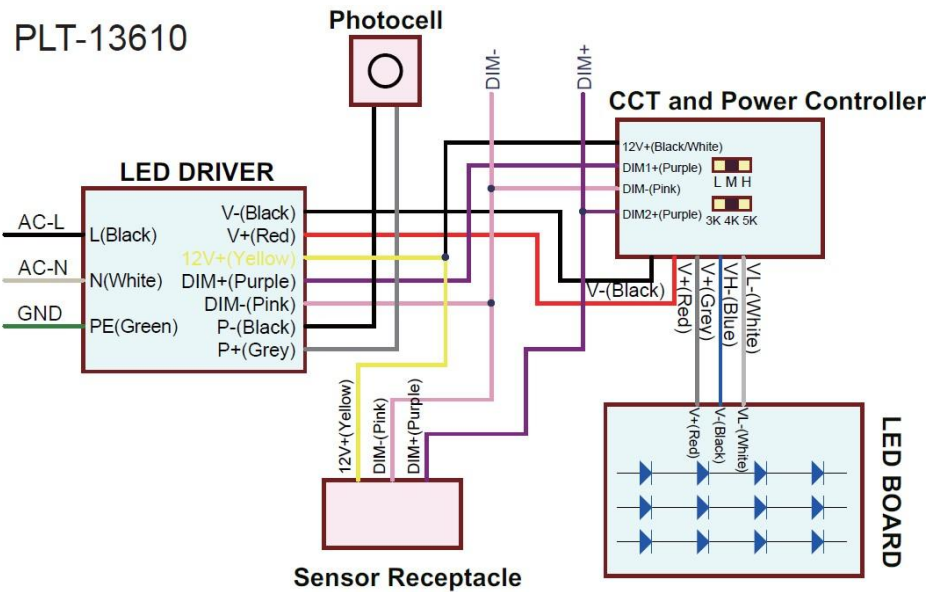


Wiring Diagram

- L/live Wire: Black/Brown
- N/Neutral Wire: White/Blue
- Ground Wire: Green/Yellow-green

Warning: During grounding, make sure the earth wire of the driver and light housing are connected together with the earth wires of the local power supply.

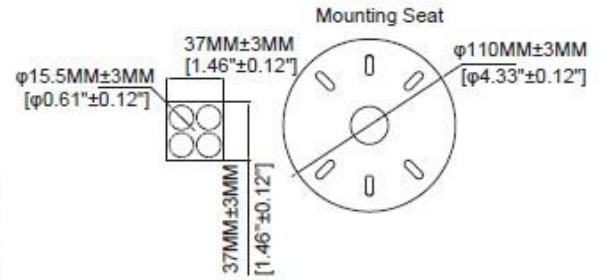
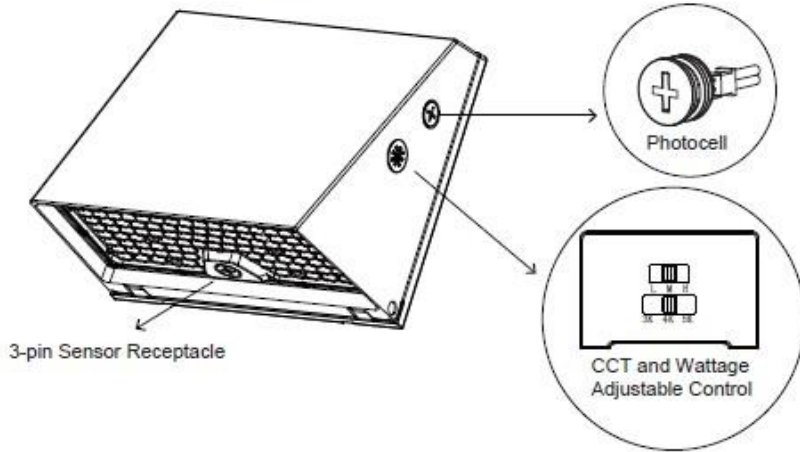
Note: This fixture includes a sensor receptacle. When a sensor is installed, it overrides the dimming circuit—do not connect to an external dimming device.



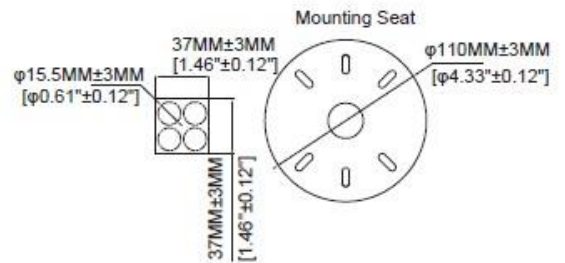
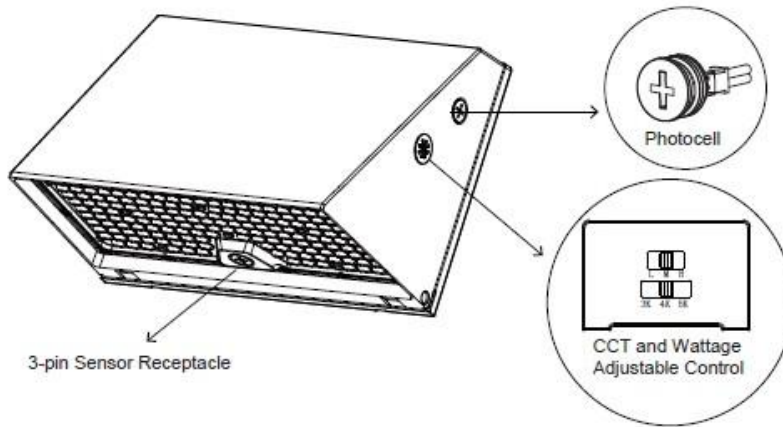


Drill Patterns

Photocell

Under the cover of the fixture, locate the male and female connectors adjacent to the 1/2" plug covering the photocell on the side of the fixture.

- Connecting the male and female connectors will activate the photocell function (Fig:1).
- Disconnecting the male and female connectors will deactivate the photocell function (Fig:2).

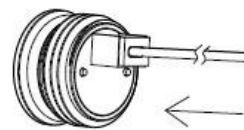

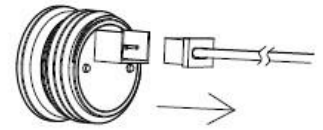

Adjustable Wattage & Color Temperature

CCT Instruction

Unscrew the 3/4" plug on the side of the fixture to reveal the two switches for color temperature and wattage.

- 3K = 3000K
- 4K = 4000K
- 5K = 5000K

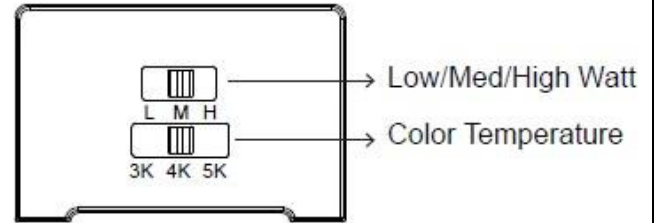
NOTE: Turn OFF the power before adjusting the color temperature or wattage selection.

Wattage Instruction

The output power of the fixture will change to the corresponding wattage when selected.

Wattage Selections:

- PLT-13610: 30W, 40W, 60W
- PLT-13611: 80W, 100W, 120W
